THE GRAND JURY CHARGES:


Felon in Possession of a Firearm


On or about August 8, 2009, in Madison County, Illinois, within the Southern District of Illinois,


CHRISTOPHER J. WICKER,

defendant herein, having previously been convicted on June 14, 2004, of a felony punishable by imprisonment for a term exceeding one year, namely, Aggravated Fleeing or Attempting to Elude a Police Officer, in the Third Judicial Circuit in Madison County, Illinois, did knowingly possess, in and affecting commerce, one or more of the following firearms, to wit, a Beretta, Model 92 FS, 9mm semiautomatic pistol bearing serial number BER385355; a Springfield Armory, Model 1911-A1, .45 caliber semiautomatic pistol, bearing serial number WW29721; a Ruger, Model Mark II, .22 caliber semiautomatic pistol, bearing serial number 225-91906, all in violation of 18 U.S.C. §§ 922(g)(1) and 924(e).
