DEFENDANT’S MOTION TO BE ALLOWED TO SELF SURRENDER
ON AUGUST 25, 2010

Comes now Defendant, by her attorney, John D. Stobbs II, and for Her Motion To Be Allowed To Self Surrender on August 25, 2010 states:

1. On June 30, 2010 Defendant appeared before this Honorable Court and was sentenced to 21 months incarceration.
2. Defendant was allowed to self-surrender to the Bureau of Prisons, and it was her hope that she would not have to self-surrender until after her son went to college.
3. However, Defendant recently received Exhibit A from the Bureau of Prisons requiring her to report to Lexington FMC SCP (F), at 12:00 noon on Tuesday, August 10, 2010.
4. As Defendant expressed at Sentencing, her oldest son was recently granted a scholarship to attend college in Chicago and Defendant would like to be given the privilege of taking her son to college on August 23, 2010.
5. No harm would result in allowing Defendant an additional two (2) weeks to surrender.
6. On July 26, 2010, the undersigned spoke with Assistant United States Attorney Steve Weinhoef who indicated that the Government has no objections to this Motion being

granted.

WHEREFORE, Defendant requests that an Order be directed to the United States Marshal allowing her to surrender herself to the Bureau of Prisons by reporting to Lexington FMC SCP (F) on August 25, 2010.
